A Vibrant Place


La Maison, nestled between vineyards and a stunning landscaped park, is deeply rooted in its natural environment. Overlooking the Rhône Valley, between the Vercors mountains and Ardèche, it opens onto a kaleidoscope of natural beauty bathed in light throughout the seasons. An authentic, inspiring place, designed to make you slow down, breathe, and reconnect.

A House That Embodies a Family Vision

This venue is the natural extension of Domaine Lombard, the family-run wine estate led by the Ardouvin family. From vineyard to venue, every space has been designed as an expression of the same philosophy: respecting the living ecosystems, revealing the potential of the place, and creating the conditions for genuine experiences. Here, owners, teams, guests, and visitors all become part of the story.

A Spirit of Creation and Sharing

La Maison invites you to awaken the senses, share emotions, and savour the moment. At the crossroads of wine, design, and conviviality, every experience is crafted to measure in a lived-in, characterful place that remains profoundly human.



Brézème, a Hidden Gem in the Rhône Valley

At the heart of the Rhône Valley, Brézème is one of the Northern Rhône's rarest and most discreet vineyards. Cultivated since the 15th century on the steep slopes of the river's left bank, this historic vineyard almost disappeared before being revived. Today, Brézème stands as an insider's vineyard, celebrated for the finesse and elegance of its wines, shaped by a preserved natural environment.

Lombard, a Living Terroir and Inspired Hospitality

A historical benchmark in Brézème, Domaine Lombard embodies both the soul and the renewal of this confidential terroir. A committed estate, where respect for life guides every decision.

La Maison was created as a distinctive hospitality venue, a natural extension of the estate where wine becomes a source of inspiration and the surrounding land an experience to be lived and shared.

A signature space, fully open to the park.



FLUID & FLEXIBLE SPACES

The venue's layout makes it possible to host one or several events at the same time, without unwanted overlap or interference, ensuring comfort, discretion, and independence for each group.



Grand Reception Hall & Event Spaces

A large, light-filled, and fully flexible space that opens onto the outdoors. The Grand Reception Hall is the vibrant heart of the venue, designed to accommodate a wide variety of formats and programmes.

Verrière

A signature space bathed in natural light. As a true transition zone, the Verrière connects the indoor spaces with the park and hosts welcomes, breaks, and informal meetings, without disrupting circulation.



Landscaped Park and Terraces

A designed, tree-filled park is the historic extension of the house—designed as a genuine living space. It links the various areas (terraces, period water basin, botanical garden, and walking paths), allowing guests to move around freely while preserving the venue's tranquillity and privacy.



Tasting Room & Underground Cellar

More confidential spaces, deliberately set apart from the main footfall areas. The Tasting Room and the historic Underground Cellar offer an intimate, private atmosphere, ideal for moments of sharing, discovery, and storytelling.



Rooms & Suites

16 rooms (single, double, twin, triple, quadruple configurations available)

- 1 accessible room (ALLY) located on the ground floor,
- 7 standard rooms,
- 7 superior rooms,
- 2 suites.

Room size: 20 to 30 m², private bathroom, separate WC.

All rooms offer uninterrupted views over the Vercors mountains (les trois becs) or the Rhône Valley and Ardèche, and provide endless vistas.

Three design atmospheres: Nature & Fraîcheur, Terre & Vigne, Minéral & Végétal.

Shared Living Spaces

A **common area** located on the first floor invites guests to gather in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere: prepare a simple meal, have a coffee, share a moment, work, talk, or simply relax.

An adjoining **terrace** extends this space during sunny days, offering an ideal setting to unwind or enjoy the calm and surrounding landscapes.

Group Stays & Shared Experiences

Make the house your own, according to your needs. Group sessions, shared meals, evening gatherings and informal moments. Partial or full privatisation depending on group size and intended use, in the spirit of a welcoming wine estate home.

Spaces & Uses


- Modular **main hall** for meals, briefings, and group sessions.


- Immersive mountain bike circuit in the heart of the vineyards, between rivers and hillsides.
